

EU funded projects

Our predecessor organization “Vocational Training SA” had been **National Agency for LdV in Greece** for both mobility and pilot projects, **between 2002-2008**. European Commission, DG Education & Culture, Leonardo Da Vinci.

1. European Commission, ESF, Article 6: Project title: **“Awise - “Ageing Workforce In Small Enterprises”**, 2005-2006, partner. The project involved managing demographic change, especially to the extent indicated in the development and trial application of specific systems and tools to support restructuring processes in SMEs and preserve the jobs of older workers. The main objective of the project was to develop new models of employment and new ways of providing education to older workers in SMEs by raising awareness of employers.
2. **Equal**: Project title: **“At wheels: next stop, labor market”** 2006-2008, partner. The project involved pilot actions aimed at people who have left school. The central issue was the investigation methodology to tackle dropout from the education system at a young age and the resulting lack of social and professional skills that lead in turn to youth unemployment or employment at a "low" level jobs.
3. European Commission, DG Education - Culture - e-learning programs: Project Title: **"G & G - Grandparents and Grandsons"**, 2007-2008, partner. The project concerned civil society activities with effort to promote dialogue between generations regarding digital illiteracy, especially in older people.
4. General Secretariat for Gender Equality - Positive action for women in Small and Large Businesses : Project Title: **"Positive actions for equality in Vocational Training SA"**, 2007-2008. The project involved the adoption of corporate social responsibility in the workplace of Vocational Training SA. The activities focused on promoting and ensuring equal opportunities in working conditions, awareness, counseling and specialized training with the process of asynchronous learning.
5. European Commission GI Education – Culture, Lifelong Learning - Leonardo da Vinci - Action 'Partnerships', Project Title: **"Partnership for Experimenting with ECVET in a Practical context"**, 2008-2009. The aim of the project was the creation of a network of several European countries - which will operate under the Network EVTA (European Vocational Training Association) in order to practice the system ECVET (credit transfer in vocational education and training).
